



HAMINA LNG LATEST DEVELOPMENT – TERMINAL RULES AND ISCC CERTIFICATE

Terminal rules

Due to the constantly changing market needs, Hamina LNG has updated its terminal rules to add even more flexibility to terminal users. Approved by the Finnish Energy Authority, and valid and available from 18 April 2024, these changes introduce shorter capacity products that can be utilized as spot capacity. The updated rules can be found at the [Materials > Instructions and rules](#) section of Hamina LNG website. The key changes include:

- Section 19
 - Spot capacity services now include daily and weekly products in addition to previously available monthly products. This applies to both storage service and regasification service.
 - Annual capacity holders are entitled to a 0.1 % discount on the fees for spot capacity services.
- Section 29
 - Regular inventory balancing has been changed from quarterly to monthly to minimize price risks for both terminal users and the terminal operator.
- Section 36
 - Addition of weekly capacity for regasification service.
- Appendix 8 – Price list
 - Starting price for monthly regasification capacity auction reduced.
 - Addition of weekly regasification service tariff.
 - Clarification of spot storage capacity pricing, and inclusion of daily and weekly storage spot tariffs.

Additional terminal rules updates for gas year 2025 (1.10.2024 – 30.9.2025) will be announced during June-August.

ISCC Certificate

Hamina LNG Oy's terminal site has recently been certified as a warehouse in accordance with ISCC EU certification system and the requirements of the RED II. The demand and supply of LBG (liquefied biogas) is expected to increase significantly in Europe in the near future, and Hamina LNG terminal can now be used as a location to import, store, and dispatch LBG.
